Which is why we decided to conduct this experiment!


We gathered, we used our intuition, we painted, we talked a lot and we had a lot of fun doing it! We were truly amazed how a person can express their feelings on a blank canvas.




NEW "DIGICOOP" PLATFROM PRESENTATION IN SKOPJE


NEW "DIGICOOP PLAFROTM" PRESENTATION IN THESSALONIKI


